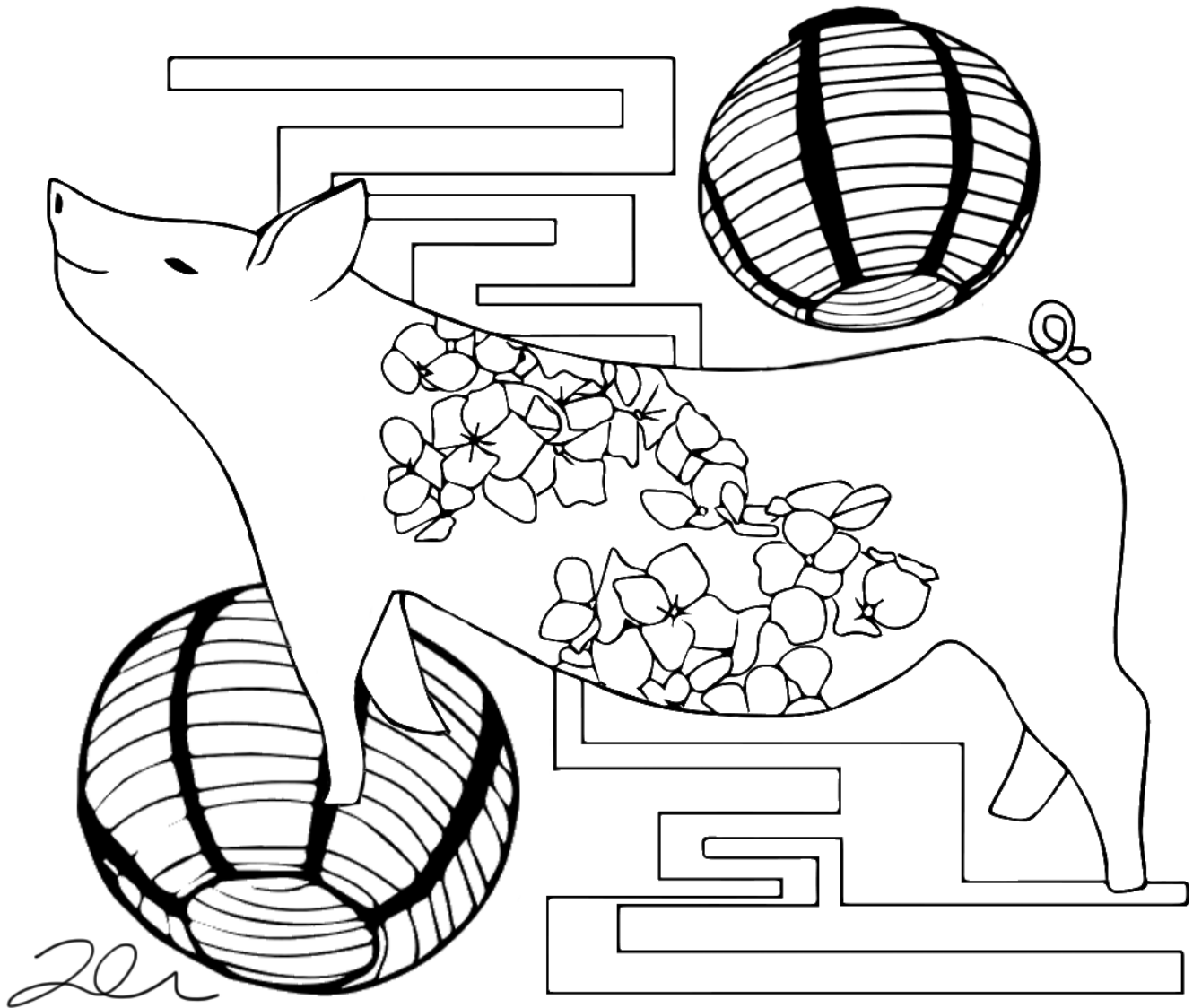

Each zodiac animal brings its own personality and characteristics to the year. Can you imagine what a pig year might look like?

**Pig years:** 1923, 1935, 1947, 1959, 1971, 1983, 1995, 2007, 2019
